

# Cleaning Advice for PVC Cover Materials

1. Do not apply detergents or solvents without testing them first. The cleaning agent must be qualified for PVC films and foils. Follow the recommendations issued by the manufacturer of the cleaning agent and airframe manufacturer.
2. Wash with warm water, cleaning agent and a soft plastic brush, then rinse thoroughly with either warm or cold water. It is advisable to dry the material before it is rolled, folded or stowed in closed boxes or similar.
3. For roll goods pressure washing outside the aircraft will also prove effective, but the pressure should be suitably adjusted so as not to damage the material or sewn seams.
4. Care should be taken not to damage the surface of the materials when treating heavy soiling such as rubber marks.
5. Avoid purely abrasive solvents, alcohol and caustic chemicals.
